Curriculum

The IB Diploma Programme is constructed around six academic areas

Students study a combination of modern languages, humanities, experimental sciences, mathematics and the creative arts. It is this comprehensive range of subjects that makes the Diploma Programme a demanding course of study designed to prepare students effectively for university entrance.

In each of the academic areas, students have flexibility in making their choices, which means they can choose subjects that particularly interest them and that they may wish to study further at university.

In addition to the six academic areas, three core elements—the extended essay, theory of knowledge and creativity, activity, service—are compulsory and central to the philosophy of the programme.





Language and literature

Studies in language and literature offer a broad range of texts, and students grow to appreciate a language's complexity, wealth and subtleties in a variety of contexts. Students take their studies in a language in which they are competent.

Language acquisition

Studies in language acquisition focus on the acquisition and use of language in a range of contexts and for different purposes while, at the same time, promoting an understanding of another culture through the study of its language.

→ Language ab initio courses are for beginners; students who have little or no previous experience of learning the language they have chosen.

Studies in mathematics are of two types. Theory of Knowledge, a course that explores the nature and sources of knowledge.

Creativity, Activity, Service (CAS), which encourages students to engage in meaningful activities outside the classroom.

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Request for information via web, email or telephone.




Submission of the required documents.
